

Instructions for Battle Boats

1. Fold bottom of boat card about 1 1/2 inches from bottom of card (so it stands up).
2. Color boat (optional).
3. Attach one piece of velcro to inside flap of boat card and the corresponding piece to the top of the main playing board. This will hold your boat card in place.
4. Cut out your cards.

Playing Instructions

1. Each player has a main playing board in front of them, along with the boat card attached.
2. Shuffle the cards and place face down in a pile so that you both can reach them.
3. Student goes first and chooses a card. Green lettered cards are beginning sounds, pink lettered cards are final sounds. The student will decide where to place his /her card keeping in mind that the goal is to make 4 'oa' words before you. The free letter card is, of course, a wild card and can be used as any letter(s).
4. When a word is formed it must be clarified with the opponent. I keep a dictionary handy so my student can check for himself.
5. Any unwanted cards are discarded to the discard pile and are later reshuffled to use
6. A card can be changed for another already placed on the main board and the used card then discarded.
7. Have fun!
